HAND KNITTING PATTERN

PROJECT LINUS BLANKET

An easy-to-knit blanket for donating to Project Linus for children in need of a hug.

Materials Required

- 150g Double Knitting yarn
- Size 8 (4mm) needles

Measurements

- Finished size = approximately 21" square.

KNITTING INSTRUCTIONS

- Cast on 130 stitches.
- Knit 10 rows in garter stitch.
- Row 11 - knit 10sts, purl 10sts, repeat to end, finishing with knit 10sts.
- Row 12 - knit 20sts, purl 10sts, repeat to end, finishing with knit 10sts.
- Continue, repeating these 2 rows as above, for 8 more rows.
- Continuing with knit 10sts at each end, knit the next 10 rows with purl 10sts over where the knit 10sts appears below.
- These 2 blocks of 10 rows form the pattern. There will be a garter stitch edge.
- Continue until there are 15 blocks.
- End with 10 rows of garter stitch.
- Cast off.
