MACHINE KNITTING PATTERN

IRENE HOLLAND'S BERET

A beret shaped using holding position.



Machine Used

- Any Standard Gauge machine can be used.

Yarn Used

- 2 Strands acrylic or 4 ply equivalent.

Tension Used

- T7

Knitting Instructions:

- Using waste yarn – Cast on over 38 needles at left of centre and 30 needles at right (68 sts).
- Centre 0 is fold line of beret.
- Knit several rows on waste yarn.
- Change to Main Yarn. Knit 2 rows, ending carriage at right.
- Set machine to Hold.
- **Put all needles at left of centre 0, except for the first 3 needles left of centre 0, into Hold Position.
- Knit 1 row left.
- Put all needles, except for the first 3 needles at right of centre 0, into Hold Position.
- Knit 1 row right.
- Continue with short rows, pushing back another 3 needles at centre on alternate sides to Working Position until 9 stitches remain in Hold Position on right hand side.
- Put next 3 needles to Work Position at left of 0.
- Knit 1 row left.
- Put the 9 needles at right to Work Position.
- Knit 1 row right.
- Continue bringing another 3 needles into Work Position at left of 0 on the next and every alternate row until 2 stitches remain in Hold Position.
- Knit 1 row to the right.
- Put the last 2 needles into Work Position and knit 2 rows**
- This completes one section.
- Repeat from ** to ** 15 times or however many you want depending on size.
- Pick up stitches from first row in main yarn and cast off.
- Neaten centre hole.
- Make a small hem round bottom edge.
