## MACHINE KNITTING PATTERN

### ADULT'S SCARF WITH FNR BORDERS AND EDGES:

A scarf with Full Needle Rib Borders and Edges to prevent frilling and give a firm edge.



#### Materials Required:

- Knitted using 3 ends of 2/30s Acrylic yarn
- Approximately 260g + extra for fringing

#### Measurements:

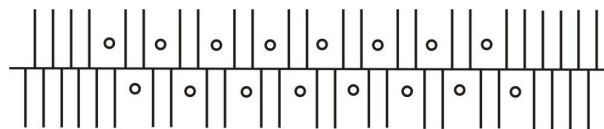
- SA (Width) 25 cm
- SB (Total length) 178 cm
- SC (Border length) 2cm
- SD (Main Pattern length) 174cm

#### Tension Square:

- T4/T4 on main bed / ribber throughout (i.e. for both FNR and 2 x 1 Rib).
- 40 stitches = 10 cm.
- 60 rows = 14.7 cm.

#### Needle Setup - Main Pattern:

- 2 x 1 Rib, with FNR at edges.



#### Knitting Instructions:

- Cast on 50 stitches each side of 0, in Full Needle Rib setup @ T0/T0.
- Knit 3 circular rows @ T1/T1.
- Knit 10 rows FNR @ T4/T4.
- Transfer stitches to Needle Setup for Main Pattern as shown above.
- Knit 710 rows @ T4/T4.
- Bring out-of-work needles back into work and fill empty needles with heels of adjacent stitches.
- Knit 10 rows FNR @ T4/T4.
- Transfer stitches to Main Bed and Cast off Loosely.

#### Fringed Edging:

- Wind yarn around fingers approximately 6 times to make loops.
- Knot loops through edge of scarf.
- Cut loops and trim to the same length all across scarf.

#### To Finish Garment:

- Steam lightly and ease to the correct length.
- This will also relax fabric and give it drape.
