MACHINE KNITTING PATTERN

SCARF WITH TWIRLS

A scarf knitted in Stocking Stitch throughout, shaped using Holding Position. With thanks to Pat Banyard-Smith for her inspiration! However, instead of punching out a punchcard and machine set to Slip Stitch, I have used Holding Position and machine set to Normal throughout.



Machine Used

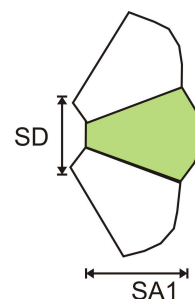
- This scarf was knitted on a Knitmaster 260, but any Standard Gauge machine can be used.

Materials Required

- This scarf was knitted using 3 ends of Uppingham's Machine Washable Merino wool but any yarn that can be steamed would be suitable.
- The scarf shown used 65g

Measurements

- SA1 (Width) 7 cm
- SD (Main Pattern length, measured down left side) 100cm



Tension Square

- T6 on main bed throughout
- 25 stitches = 7 cm.
- 1 panel = 1.3 cm (measured on left side).

Needle Setup

- 25 needles in WP on Main Bed



Knitting Instructions:

- Latch tool cast on 25 stitches, starting at the left.
- With CAR, knit 2 rows, ending CAR. (RC.2)
- **Set carriage to Hold.
- Bring 1 needle at left to HP and knit to left. (RC.3)
- Bring 1 needle at left to HP and knit to right. (This prevents holes by doing an automatic wrap). (RC.4).
- Bring 1 needle at left to HP and knit to left. (RC.5).
- Continue bringing 1 needle at left to HP on every row and knitting across, until all but the last needle on the right are in HP, ending CAR. (RC.26).
- Set carriage to normal knitting and knit 2 rows, ending CAR. (RC.28). **

- Repeat from ** to ** as required.
- Cast off using latch tool.
- WEIGHTS: It is necessary to constantly reposition the weights on the knitting, especially on the right-hand side.
- NUMBER OF PANELS: I knitted 75 repeats which, once washed and steamed, gave a length of 100cm measured along the left side of the knitting (i.e. the shortest side). However, this length can be adjusted by knitting extra pattern repeats.

To Finish Scarf:

- Steam to death, to stop stocking stitch fabric curling.
- This will also relax fabric and give it drape.
- For wearing as a scarf, find the centre point. Twist twirls in opposite directions so that the Stocking Stitch side faces outwards on each side.
